Voter Education and Registration:

- Continue and expand outreach to local high schools
- Expand outreach to PSU campus, including coordination with leadership, candidate information, and information regarding polling places.
- Promote the use of use of remote ballot boxes for mail-in ballots.

Committees:

Educational Forums:

- Devise alternative methods of educational forums given the COVID-19 commonwealth restrictions.
